

# Reason for the change to the Construction Management @ Risk (CM@R) Selection Process

Governor's Office, Office of Planning and Budget and State Property Officer requested we develop a process that considered price as part of the selection process for Construction Professionals

## Step 1: Statement of Qualifications Evaluation Criteria Modifications

### **Previous Criteria Categories**

Stability 30% Experience & Qualifications 40% Suitability 30%

### **Revised Criteria Categories**

Stability 20%
Experience & Qualifications 40%
Suitability 40%

# Step 2: Qualifications Proposals & Interview Evaluation Criteria Modifications

### **Previous Proposal Criteria**

Relevance of Team Experience - 20%

Previous Performance - 15%

Management Plan 15%

Methodology Presented - 25%

Overall Impression - 25%

### **Current Proposal Criteria**

Qualifications and Experience - 50%

Management Plan - 25%

Overall Impression - 25%

### Revised Evaluation Criteria Statements of Qualifications

**20%** - **Stability**: Stability of the firm, including the firm's corporate history, growth, resources, form of ownership, litigation history, financials, etc.

**40%** - Experience and Qualifications: Firm's relevant project experience and qualifications, including the demonstrated ability of firm in effective management of construction of facilities comparable in complexity, size, and function, for Owners such as the State of Georgia and other similarly-structured organizations. This includes relevant experience and qualifications of the firm's principal Project Executive, Project Manager, and/or Superintendents; and the demonstrated proficiency of the firm in projects similar to this Project.

**40%** - **Suitability:** Firm's suitability to provide services for project, including whether the firm's size and resources are appropriate in relation to the size and complexity of the project, any unique qualifications for the project, current and projected workloads, the proximity of office to project location, knowledge of or experience with the local subcontractor market, non-discrimination policies, and record of addressing public safety, social, environmental concerns, accessibility for persons with disabilities and special needs, and special services for project-related concerns

### Revised Request for Qualifications Deliverables

- Revised Deliverable for Experience and Qualifications
- B-1 Describe your firm's proposed construction management team. Please designate the specific individuals who will fill the key roles on your team and provide a resume for each individual. Firms should list all positions/persons that CM expects to serve on the construction management team or who's time will be charged to the project. This will include, but is not limited to:
- a. Superintendent(s)
- b. Project Manager
- · c. Project Director
- d. Cost Estimator
- · e. Project Executive
- f. Other project management/support staff, etc.

### Revised Request for Qualifications Deliverables

#### Revised Deliverable C – Statement of Suitability:

- C-1: Provide any information that may serve to differentiate the firm from other firms in suitability for the project. Suitability may include, but is not limited to, the size and resources of the firm as related to the size and complexity of the Project, any special or unique qualifications for the project, current and projected workloads, and any techniques or methodologies offered by the firm that may be particularly suitable for this project type.
- C-2: Describe non-discrimination policies and describe the firm's record and methodologies of addressing public safety, social, environmental, accessibility for persons with disabilities and special needs, or other related concerns.
- C-3: Indicate the proximity of the Project Site to the firm's office that will be managing the Project and firm's knowledge of or experience with the local subcontractor market.

## Revised Selection Criteria for Evaluation of Proposal & Interviews

- 50% Qualifications & Experience: Relevant Experience and Qualifications of the Proposed Project Team including: experience of the project manager and superintendent working together on past similar projects; experience of the team working together with the selected Design Professional and/or Program Manager; team's experience with projects of similar facility size, type, and complexity. The Owner may use references from stakeholders of the Owner's choosing from previous projects of the finalists, among other information as necessary.
- 25% Proposed Management Plan: Quality of proposed Management Plan, including: firm's cost management plan; firm's schedule management plan; firm's approach for managing changes within the stated cost and schedule limitations; firm's approach for competitively administering and evaluating bid packages; the firm's subcontractor management plan; the firm's quality assurance program and plan; the firm's close-out plan; the firm's site logistics plan for proposed project
- 25% Overall Impression: Committee's Overall Impression of the firm and the overall impression of key team members and their ability to effectively answer project questions and provide solutions during the interview.

# Summary of the Modifications to the CM/GC Selection Process Modifications

- RFQ Step 1 Evaluation criteria was modified by:
  - ➤ Placing more emphasis on "right sizing" firms to projects
  - Placing more importance on consideration of local firms
  - > Placing more emphasis on local subcontractor participation
- The revised RFQ requires firms to submit detailed information pertaining to entire proposed project team including resumes for each member
- The revised RFP evaluation criteria was consolidated and scoring now combines previous scoring for both the team qualifications and the interviews, placing increased emphasis on the firms' construction qualifications and reducing the emphasis on their ability to interview well
- Final Selection is based on a combination of qualifications and cost of CM/GC's General Conditions and Construction Fee
